Re: Freedom of Information Law Request

Dear Records Access Officer:

My name is Brad Maurer, Esq., and I am a Staff Attorney at New York County Defender Services, a New York City public defender office. My office represents individuals as assigned by the Supreme Court of the State of New York pursuant to the U.S. Constitutional mandate to provide representation to all Defendants, criminally charged, facing the possible loss of property, liberty, or both when such Defendants have been deemed indigent by a court of competent jurisdiction. Many of our clients are incarcerated and currently face major risks as a result of the ongoing coronavirus pandemic that has spread quickly in the jails.

At the New York City Board of Correction hearing held on May 12, 2020, and again at the New York City Council hearing on May 19, 2020, officials from Correctional Health Services and the Department of Corrections stated that those agencies have been collecting and monitoring several categories of data pertaining to the COVID-19 outbreak in New York City's jails, including:

- daily new COVID-19 test results;
- daily COVID-related hospitalizations;
- the daily number of COVID-19 tests administered (and the daily proportion of those tests which are coming back positive for COVID-19);
- data pertaining to the COVID-19 testing of new admissions to NYC jails; and
- the accuracy and/or reliability of the COVID-19 test(s) being administered in NYC jails.

Under the provisions of the New York Freedom of Information Law, Article 6 of the Public Officers Law, I hereby request Correctional Health Services records pertaining to data collected and maintained by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections

concerning COVID-19 infections, hospitalizations, testing, and deaths among those incarcerated and working in the New York City jails. Specifically, I request any and all Correctional Health Services records containing any and all information regarding:

1. The **daily number of new positive diagnoses** of SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) among: (a) persons in Department of Corrections custody; (b) Department of Corrections staff; (c) Correctional Health Services staff; and (d) any other person(s) for whom Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections is tracking this data, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date and by the categories of persons listed immediately above.
2. The **daily number** of persons in Department of Corrections custody who are **newly hospitalized** for known or suspected COVID-related illness, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date.
3. The **daily total number** of persons in Department of Corrections custody who are as of that date **hospitalized**, regardless of their hospital admission date, for known or suspected COVID-related illness, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date.
4. The **daily number** of SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) polymerase chain reaction (**PCR**) **diagnostic tests administered** by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections to: (a) persons in Department of Corrections custody; (b) Department of Corrections staff; (c) Correctional Health Services staff; and (d) any other person(s) for whom Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections is tracking this data, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date and by the categories of persons listed immediately above.
5. The **daily proportion** of SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) polymerase chain reaction (**PCR**) **diagnostic test results** received by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections which returned as **positive** for SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) regarding: (a) persons in Department of Corrections custody; (b) Department of Corrections staff; (c) Correctional Health Services staff; and (d) any other person(s) for whom Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections is tracking this data, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date and by the categories of persons listed immediately above.
6. The **daily number** of SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) polymerase chain reaction (**PCR**) **diagnostic tests administered** to persons **newly admitted** into Department of Corrections custody after March 1, 2020, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date.

7. The **daily proportion** of SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) polymerase chain reaction (**PCR**) **diagnostic test results** received by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections which returned as **positive** for SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) regarding persons **newly admitted** into Department of Corrections custody after March 1, 2020, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date.
8. The **identity** of the specific SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) polymerase chain reaction (**PCR**) **diagnostic test(s)** administered by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections to: (a) persons in Department of Corrections custody; (b) Department of Corrections staff; (c) Correctional Health Services staff; and (d) any other person(s) to whom Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections is administering COVID-19 PCR diagnostic tests. This portion of the request for records includes but is not limited to the name of each test's **manufacturer** and the **name of the specific test(s)** that have been used.
9. The **accuracy** and/or **reliability** of the specific SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) polymerase chain reaction (**PCR**) **diagnostic test(s)** administered by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections to: (a) persons in Department of Corrections custody; (b) Department of Corrections staff; (c) Correctional Health Services staff; and (d) any other person(s) to whom Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections is administering COVID-19 PCR diagnostic tests. This portion of the request for records includes but is not limited to information pertaining to **sensitivity, specificity, positive predictive value, and negative predictive value**, as well as any known **empirical basis** for any estimates of the test characteristics listed immediately above. (For reference, at the May 19 City Council hearing, Correctional Health Services Chief Medical Officer Ross MacDonald stated that the PCR test being administered in NYC jails has a “sensitivity of approximately 90%.”)
10. The **daily number** of SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) **antibody tests administered** by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections to: (a) persons in Department of Corrections custody; (b) Department of Corrections staff; (c) Correctional Health Services staff; and (d) any other person(s) to whom Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections is administering COVID-19 antibody tests, from the dates of March 1, 2020, through the date this request is fulfilled by Correctional Health Services, disaggregated by date and by the categories of persons listed immediately above.
11. The **daily proportion** of SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) **antibody test results** received by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections which returned as **positive** for SARS-CoV-2 (a.k.a. 15. The **accuracy** and/or **reliability** of the specific SARS-COV-2 (a.k.a. COVID-19) **antibody test(s)** administered by Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections to: (a) persons in Department of Corrections custody; (b) Department of Corrections staff; (c) Correctional Health Services staff; and (d) any other person(s) to whom Correctional Health Services and/or the Department of Corrections is administering COVID-19 antibody tests. This portion of the request for records includes but is not limited to information pertaining to **sensitivity**, **specificity**, **positive predictive value**, and **negative predictive value**, as well as any known **empirical basis** for any estimates of the test characteristics listed above.

The above-described information sought in this request was referenced by Correctional Health Services and/or Department of Corrections officials at the Board of Correction and City Council oversight hearings on May 12 and May 19, respectively; indeed, at least some of the above-described information was discussed by Senior Vice President of Correctional Health Services Patricia Yang at the May 19 City Council hearing as being “part of our patient management” and “allow[ing Correctional Health Services] to manage the clinical care that we provide.” Therefore, the records sought herein should be readily available.

As you know, the Freedom of Information Law requires that an agency respond to a

request within five business days of receipt. Therefore, I would appreciate a response as soon as possible and look forward to hearing from you shortly. If for any reason any portion of my request is denied, please inform me of the reasons for the denial in writing (via e-mail) and provide the name and address of the person or body to whom an appeal should be directed. If possible, please send the requested records via e-mail.

This responds to your FOIL request dated May 25, 2020.
The attached excel document shows responses to items no. 1,3,4,5,6 &7.
Answers to items 8-9 are as follows:


CHS uses a widely-used test through our lab vendor BioReference which has been approved by the FDA under an Emergency Use Authorization. We were informed at the start of our testing initiative that the performance of the COVID-19 test we are using was 97.1% Sensitivity and 99.3% Specificity. Test characteristics may be different in the real world application and a commonly used physician reference notes that “The accuracy and predictive values of SARS-CoV-2 NAAT have not been systematically evaluated, and the sensitivity of testing likely depends on the precise assay, the type of specimen obtained, the quality of the specimen, and duration of illness at the time of testing.” (UpToDate Online). The test used by CHS can be found at the following website and the lab vendor may have additional or updated validation information:

Positive predictive value and negative predictive value are testing characteristics that depend on the prevalence of a condition in a population. As a rapidly spreading and, in most cases, a quickly resolving (1 – 2 weeks) condition, the PPV and NPV are regularly changing and it would not be accurate to provide a general statement about these values.

There are no data responsive to items 2, or 10-15.

This FOIL request is now closed.
